



# Gift Basket Raffle Donations



Donated a themed basket for our gift basket raffle at this year's Fiesta. Be creative! Drop off completed baskets with donation slip to the Parish Office by noon on Thursday, May 31.

\*Please note that baskets may not contain alcohol or gift cards for liquor stores.

1. Select a theme and go shopping for items. Aim for between 5 and 10 items with about a \$50 total value. Don't forget a basket or container that goes with your theme!
2. Add a layer of tissue paper to the bottom of your container to help prop up items. If using a large container, use newspaper or even a small cardboard box (which you can then cover in tissue paper).
3. Place a sturdy item in the center. Add larger or taller items behind the center item. Place smaller items toward the front. Use glue dots or tape to secure items to each other to keep them in place.
5. Open the cellophane bag and roll down the sides down. Have one person hold the bag while the other lifts the basket and lowers it into the bag.
6. If you have any especially large items that didn't fit in the basket, you can tuck them into the bag behind the basket.
7. Twist the top of the cellophane bag closed. Use wide, wired ribbon for the bow; it's sturdy and can be shaped into place.
